


STORM DRAIN DUMPING SEE IT, REPORT IT!

- GET LICENSE PLATE NUMBER
- TAKE A PICTURE
- DESCRIBE PERSON
- NOTE PLACE AND TIME
- SUBSTANCE AND AMOUNT
